Selection Process of M.Phil Programme in Philosophy

- Candidates have to score a minimum of 25 marks (50% of the total) to be eligible for the viva-voce (5% relaxation for SC,ST, OBC/differently abled)
- For selection 25% weightage will be given to the marks obtained in viva-voce and 25% weightage will be given to the aggregate marks obtained in the Master's Programme
- **Interview/ Viva-Voce Pattern for Admission in M.phil Programme in Philosophy:**

The viva-voce will be of 50 marks. Candidates who have been exempted from appearing in the written examination will also be required to appear in the interview. Candidates will be tested on the basis of their general understanding of the subject as well as their research aptitude.

Ph.D. Programme in Philosophy

Question Pattern for **RET**:

- 10 multiple choice type questions on research methodology and subject each carrying 2 marks (20 marks)
- An essay on any one topics (20 marks)
- Comprehension (10 marks)
- Total marks in **RET**: 50 marks
