## **Question pattern for Ph.D. RET 2020-21**

### **Bengali:**

- 5 multiple type questions each carrying 2 marks (10 Marks)
- 4 short notes each carrying 5 marks (20 Marks)
- Research proposal: 10 marks
- 1 descriptive type question carrying 10 marks (10 Marks)

### **Education:**

- 1 Research Proposal- 20 marks
- 3 Essay type question- 10 marks each (3x10= 30)

### **Political Science:**

- 2 analytical type questions out of 4 on Research Methodology each carrying 10 marks (20 Marks)
- 2 analytical type questions out of 4 on Subject Concerned each carrying 10 marks (20 Marks)
- Research proposal: 10 marks

### **History:**

- 2 analytical type questions on Research Methodology each carrying 10 marks (20 Marks)
- 2 analytical type questions on Subject related each carrying 10 marks (20 Marks)
- 5 multiple choice type questions each carrying 2 marks (10 Marks)

### **English:**

- 10 multiple choice type questions each carrying 2 marks (10x2=20 Marks)
- 4 descriptive type questions (4x5=20 Marks)
- 1 Essay out of a choice of topics: (10 marks)

### **Philosophy:**

- 10 multiple choice type questions on Research Methodology and subject each carrying 2 marks (20 Marks)
- An essay on any topics (20 Marks)
- Comprehension (10 marks)

### **Physics:**

- 50 multiple choice questions each carrying 1 (one) marks = 50 Marks (No negative marking).

### **Chemistry:**

- Syllabus: CSIR-UGC NET Examination
- MCQ type
- Marks: 50
- Total question: 50

(Each question will contain 2 marks and 25% negative marks on wrong answer)  
(Students should attempt only 25 questions)

**Zoology:**

- There will be multiple choice questions (MCQ) of total 20 marks and analytical descriptive questions of total 30 marks.
- There will be 20 MCQ questions each of 1 mark and 6 descriptive questions (out of 10) each of 5 marks. No options will be given for MCQ questions.
- There will be no negative marking for MCQ type questions.

**Geography:**

- There will be multiple choice questions (MCQ) of total 30 marks and analytical descriptive questions of total 20 marks.
- Total Marks: 50 Marks.
- There will be no negative marking.

**Mathematics:**

- 50 multiple choice questions each carrying 1 (one) marks = 50 Marks (No negative marking).
