Ph.D programme:

1. Eligibility Criteria:

Women candidates having a Master's degree in her own discipline or in an equivalent subject or a degree declared equivalent to Masters degree by the corresponding statutory regulatory body with at least 55% marks in aggregate or its equivalent grade "B" in the UGC 7 point scale (or an equivalent grade in a point scale wherever grading system is followed) or an equivalent degree from foreign educational institution accredited by an Assessment and Accreditation Agency, may apply for admission to the Ph.D programme. There will be a relaxation of 5% of marks or an equivalent relaxation of grade for SC/ST/OBC (non-creamy layer)/ differently abled candidates.

2. Selection Procedure:

The following procedures will be adopted for the selection of eligible candidates in Ph.D. Programme.

- a. The admission to Ph.D. programme would be on the basis of RET and it is to be conducted by the concerned department followed by an interview for the candidates qualifying in RET.
- b. The candidates who have qualified NET/SLET/SET/GATE or any other equivalent examinations are exempted from RET and can appear in the interview.
- c. The candidates who have qualified M.Phil. in the subject concerned under UGC regulation 2009 would be exempted from RET and to be considered for appearing before the interview board.

The candidates qualified NET/SLET/SET/GATE or any other equivalent examinations, qualified M.Phil. in the subject concerned under UGC regulation 2009 and qualified in RET will have to appear in an interview with a research proposal (1000 words).

3. Duration of Ph.D programme:

The Ph.D programme shall be for a minimum duration of three years, including course work and a maximum of six years. As per the guidelines of the UGC, women candidates and Persons with Disability (more than 40% disability) may be allowed a relaxation of two years in the maximum duration. In addition, women candidates may be provided

Maternity Leave/Child Care Leave once in the entire duration of Ph.D for a maximum period of 240 days.

Registration Fees: Rupees Five Thousand only.

4. **Reservation Policies:** Reservation of seats for SC/ST/OBC-A/OBC-B will be as per the reservation policy of Government of West Bengal. ST/ SC/OBC-A/OBC-B of the States other than West Bengal are not entitled to get the benefit rules of Government of West Bengal, as per circular Nos. BC-16014/1/82-SC dt.06/08/1984 & BCD-1, D.O.12017/11/89-SCD (R.CELL) dt.09/01/1990 and letter No.1510-SCW dt.31/05/2007 from the Government of West Bengal. Scheduled Castes/ Scheduled Tribes of the States other than West Bengal are not entitled to get the benefit of reserved quota in Educational Institutions in West Bengal. Such students may get the benefit of reserve quota if they have domicile certificate of 10 years residency in West Bengal.

M.Phil. Programme

1. Eligibility Criteria:

Candidates who have a Masters Degree or a degree declared equivalent to Masters degree by the corresponding statutory regulatory body with at least 55% marks in aggregate or its equivalent grade “B” in the UGC 7 point scale (or an equivalent grade in a point scale wherever grading system is followed) or an equivalent degree from a foreign educational institution accredited by an Assessment and Accreditation Agency, may apply for admission to the M.Phil programme. There will be a relaxation of 5% of marks or an equivalent relaxation of grade for SC/ST/OBC (non-creamy layer)/differently abled candidates.

2. Course Fees: 4000/- (Four Thousand only)

3. Selection Procedure:

The candidates found eligible as per the above stated criteria must appear in a written examination and viva-voce. Candidates who have qualified the NET/SET/SLET examination are exempted from appearing in the written examination.

4. Syllabus, question pattern & qualifying marks of the entrance examination:

• Syllabus:

Candidates will be evaluated on their knowledge and understanding of the concerned subject as taught at the post graduate level in different universities/post graduate colleges in West Bengal.

- **Qualifying Marks:** The candidate has to score a minimum of 25 marks (50% of the total) to be eligible for the Viva Voce (5% relaxation for SC, ST, OBC/differently abled).
5. **Interview:** The interview is of 50 marks. Candidates who have been exempted from appearing in the written examination will also be required to appear in the interview. Candidates will be tested on their general understanding of the subject at the interview. They are also expected to discuss their research area in the interview and are requested to submit a research proposal within 1000 words at the time of viva-voce.
 6. **Reservation Policies:** Reservation of seats for SC/ST/OBC-A/OBC-B will be made as per the rules of Government of West Bengal, as per circular Nos. BC-16014/1/82-SC dt.06/08/1984 & BCD-1, D.O.12017/11/89-SCD (R.CELL) dt.09/01/1990 and letter No.1510-SCW dt.31/05/2007 from the Government of West Bengal. Scheduled Castes/ Scheduled Tribes of the States other than West Bengal are not entitled to get the benefit of reserved quota in Educational Institutions in West Bengal. Such students may get the benefit of reserve quota if they have domicile certificate of 10 years residency in West Bengal.

7. Duration of the M.Phil programme: 2 years/4 semesters

As per UGC guidelines, women candidates and Persons with Disability (more than 40% disability) may be allowed a relaxation of one year. In addition, the women candidates may be provided Maternity Leave/Child Care Leave once in the entire duration of the programme for a maximum period of 240 days.

Candidates are requested to download the PDF format of the **application form** from the University website i.e. www.dhwu.ac.in and submit the duly filled-in form along with attested supporting documents and a Demand Draft of **Rupees Four Hundred only** in favor of *Diamond Harbour Women's University* payable at Sarisha. **Candidates applying for both M.Phil & Ph.D programmes are advised to apply through separate forms and pay separately.**
