ADMISSION NOTICE

Doctor of Philosophy in Bengali

&

Master of Philosophy in Bengali (2 years regular course)

Applications are invited from eligible candidates (**Women only**) willing to take admission to the M.Phil & Ph.D programme in Bengali for the academic session 2017-18.

Details for M.Phil. programme in Bengali 2017

Eligibility:

- Candidates who have completed results of Masters Course (M.A) in Bengali or equivalent subjects with at least 55% marks or its equivalent grade 'B' in the UGC 7-point scale (5% relaxation for reserved candidates) may apply for admission to M.Phil Course for the academic session 2017- 18.
- **Current** students of M.A course who have appeared or due to appear in final Examination of M.A. in the present academic session can apply if they obtained at least 40% marks in each course/ paper considering 1st, 2nd and 3rd semester. However they have to obtain at least 55% marks or equivalent grade 'B' in the UGC 7-point scale (5% relaxation for reserved candidates) **in the aggregate. At the time of counseling/ admission those students (if provisionally selected) must submit a proof of completion of M.A Final Examination, 2017 authenticated by the appropriate authority of her college/ institute/ university.** They will be required to submit their mark-sheet before appearing the semester examination 2017.

Course Fees: 4000/- (Four Thousand only)**Selection Procedure:**

The candidates formed eligible as per the above stated criteria must appear in a written examination and Viva-Voce organized by the University.

Syllabus, question pattern & qualifying marks of the entrance examination:

The syllabus of the entrance test contains overall syllabus taught in M.A curriculum of Bengali in Universities.

Qualifying Marks: The qualifying mark is 50% (5% relaxation for SC, ST, OBC-A, OBC-B) to appear in the Viva-Voce.

Viva-Voce: Candidates are requested to prepare and submit a Statement of Purpose (within 1000 words) about her research planning at the time of viva-voce.

Number of seats: Reservation of seats for SC/ST/OBC-A/OBC-B will be made as per the rules of Government of West Bengal.

As per circular Nos. BC-16014/1/82-SC dt.06/08/1984 & BCD-1, D.O.12017/11/89-SCD(R.CELL) dt.09/01/1990 and letter No.1510-SCW dt.31/05/2007 from the Government of West Bengal, Scheduled Castes/ Scheduled Tribes of the States other than West Bengal are not entitled to get the benefit of reserved quota in Educational Institutions in West Bengal. Such students may get the benefit of reserve quota if they have domicile certificate of 10 years residency in West Bengal.

Duration of the Programme:

M.Phil. programme shall be for a minimum duration of two (2) consecutive semesters / one year and a maximum of four (4) consecutive semesters / two years.

As per the UGC guideline, women candidates and Persons with Disability (more than 40% disability) may be allowed a relaxation of one year for M.Phil programme. In addition, the women candidates may be provided Maternity Leave/Child Care Leave once in the entire duration of M.Phil for up to 240 days.

Application Fees: Rupees Four Hundred only

Application Procedure:

Candidates are requested to download the PDF format of the **application form** from the university website i.e www.dhwu.ac.in and submit the filled up form along with a Demand Draft of rupees four hundred only in favor of *Diamond Harbour Women's University* payable at Diamond Harbour .

Details for Ph.D. programme in Bengali 2017

Eligibility:

Candidates having Master's degree in Bengali or in equivalent subject with at least 55% (relaxation of 5% for reserved candidates) may apply for the Ph.D programme in Bengali.

Selection Procedure:

In addition to the above mentioned qualification an applicant must also fulfill any one of the following conditions to attend the viva-voce for Ph.D admission.

1. Qualified in any of the following examinations- UGC- NET/ SET.
2. Obtained M.Phil degree in Bengali or in relevant subjects from a recognized University/ Institution (that also followed the UGC minimum standard for M.Phil. & Ph.D. regulation 2016).
3. An applicant whose M.Phil dissertation has been evaluated and the viva-voce is pending may also apply for the Ph.D programme.
4. Candidates who have not fulfilled any of the conditions mentioned above will have to qualify in the **Research Eligibility Test (RET)** conducted by Bengali department.

Syllabus, question pattern & qualifying marks of the RET:

The syllabus of the entrance test contains overall syllabus taught in M.A/ M.Phil curriculum of Bengali in the Universities.

Qualifying Marks: The qualifying mark is 50% (5% relaxation for SC, ST, OBC-A, OBC-B) to appear in the Viva-Voce.

Viva-Voce: An interview/ viva-voce which is mandatory for all applicants, to be organized by Bengali department when the applicants are required to submit a statement of purpose (within 1500 words) and discuss their research interest/ area through a presentation before the departmental research committee.

Duration of Ph.D programme:

Ph.D. programme shall be for a minimum duration of three years, including course work and a maximum of six years.

As per the guideline of UGC, women candidates and Persons with Disability (more than 40% disability) may be allowed a relaxation two years for Ph.D. in the maximum duration. In addition, the women candidates may be provided Maternity Leave/Child Care Leave once in the entire duration of Ph.D. for up to 240 days.

Course Fees: Rupees Five Thousand only.

Number of seats: Reservation of seats for SC/ST/OBC-A/OBC-B will be made as per the rules of Government of West Bengal.

As per circular Nos. Now the University is recognized by the UGC 2(f) but not covered under UGC 12(b). The admitted students for M.Phil & Ph.D degree in the academic session 2017-18 will not be able to receive any fellowship/ grants from University Grants Commission.
4. Ragging is a punishable offence and students are required to submit – affidavit of Antiragging.

Note: The Master of Philosophy & Doctor of Philosophy programmes in Bengali will be controlled by the M.Phil & Ph.D Rules & Regulations of Diamond Harbour Women's University and Regulations published in 13th July 2016 (UGC Minimum Standards and Procedure for Award of M.PHIL./PH.D Degrees Regulations, 2016).
