Applications are invited from eligible candidates (**women only**) willing to take admission to the M.Phil and Ph.D programme for the academic session 2022.

Informations regarding Ph.D. programme:

1. Eligibility Criteria:

Women candidates having a Master's degree in her own discipline or in an equivalent subject or a degree declared equivalent to Masters degree by the corresponding statutory regulatory body with at least 55% marks in aggregate or its equivalent grade "B" in the UGC 7 point scale (or an equivalent grade in a point scale wherever grading system is followed) or an equivalent degree from foreign educational institution accredited by an Assessment and Accreditation Agency, may apply for admission to the Ph.D programme. There will be a relaxation of 5% of marks or an equivalent relaxation of grade for SC/ST/OBC (non-creamy layer)/ differently abled candidates.

2. Selection Procedure:

The following procedures will be adopted for the selection of eligible candidates in Ph.D. Programme.

- a. The admission to Ph.D. programme would be on the basis of Research Eligibility Test (RET) and it is to be conducted by the concerned department followed by an interview for the candidates qualifying in RET.
- b. The candidates who have qualified NET/SLET/SET/GATE or any other equivalent examinations are exempted from RET and can appear directly in the interview.
- c. The candidates who have qualified M.Phil. in the subject concerned under UGC regulation 2009 would be exempted from RET and to be considered for appearing before the interview board.

The candidates qualified NET/SLET/SET/GATE or any other equivalent examinations, qualified M.Phil. in the subject concerned under UGC regulation 2009 and qualified in RET will have to appear in an interview with a research proposal (1000 words).

3. Duration of Ph.D programme:

The Ph.D programme shall be for a minimum duration of three years, including course work and a maximum of six years. As per the guidelines of the UGC, women candidates and Persons with Disability (more than 40% disability) may be allowed a relaxation of two years in the maximum duration. In addition, women candidates may be provided Maternity Leave/Child Care Leave once in the entire duration of Ph.D for a maximum period of 240 days.

Enrolment Fees: Rupees Five Thousand only.

5. **Application Fees: Rupees Five Hundred only**
6. **Application Procedure:**

Candidates are requested to download the PDF format of the **application form** from the University website i.e. www.dhwu.ac.in and submit the duly filled-in application form along with attested supporting documents and a Demand Draft of Rupees Five Hundred only drawn in favor of **Diamond Harbour Women's University** payable at Sarisha. Information regarding M.Phil. Programme

1. **Eligibility Criteria:**

Candidates who have a Masters Degree or a degree declared equivalent to Masters degree by the corresponding statutory regulatory body with at least 55% marks in aggregate or its equivalent grade "B" in the UGC 7 point scale (or an equivalent grade in a point scale wherever grading system is followed) or an equivalent degree from a foreign educational institution accredited by an Assessment and Accreditation Agency, may apply for admission to the M.Phil programme. There will be a relaxation of 5% of marks or an equivalent relaxation of grade for SC/ST/OBC (non-creamy layer)/differently abled candidates.

2. Course Fees: 5000/- (Five Thousand only)

3. Selection Procedure:

The candidates found eligible as per the above stated criteria must appear in a **written examination and viva-voce**. Candidates who have qualified the NET/SET/SLET/GATE/Equivalent examination are exempted from appearing in the written examination. They can appear before interview board directly.

4. Syllabus & qualifying marks of the entrance examination:

• **Syllabus:**

Candidates will be evaluated on their knowledge and understanding of the concerned subject as taught at the post graduate level in different universities/post graduate colleges in West Bengal.

- **Qualifying Marks:** The candidate has to score a minimum of 25 marks (50% of the total) to be eligible for the Viva Voce (5% relaxation for SC, ST, OBC, PD candidates may be permissible).

- 5. Interview:** The interview is of 50 marks. Candidates who have exempted from appearing in the written examination will also be required to appear in the interview. Candidates will be tested on their general understanding of the subject at the interview. They are also expected to discuss their research area in the interview and are requested to submit a research proposal within 1000 words at the time of viva-voce.

6. Reservation Policies: As per Govt. rules

7. Duration of the M.Phil programme: 2 years/4 semesters

As per UGC guidelines, women candidates and Persons with Disability (more than 40% disability) may be allowed a relaxation of one year. In addition, the women candidates may be provided Maternity Leave/Child Care Leave once in the entire duration of the programme for a maximum period of 240 days.

8. Application Fees: Rupees Four Hundred only

9. Application Procedure:

Candidates are requested to download the PDF format of the **application form** from the University website i.e. www.dhwu.ac.in and submit the duly filled-in form along with attested supporting documents and a Demand Draft of **Rupees Four Hundred only** in favor of *Diamond Harbour Women's University* payable at Sarisha. **Candidates applying for both M.Phil & Ph.D programmes are advised to apply through separate forms and pay separately.**
