PG GIRLS' HOSTEL. Session 2021-2022

DIRECTIVES FOR APPLICANTS:

- Accommodation at the PG Girls' Hostel will commence from 1st December, 2021.
- Accommodation is currently being allowed with 50 percent occupancy maintaining the Covid protocol. Subsequent allotment lists will be put up after 1st January, 2022 (tentatively).
- **4** The formal Rules and Regulations will be published in the University Website.
- Hostel applicants will need to pay an Accommodation Fee of Rs. 1,200/-, an Admission Fee of Rs. 1000/- and a Caution Deposit of Rs. 1000/- (refundable) [Total amount = Rs. 3,200/-] on 1st December, 2021 at the Finance Section, University Office, Administrative Building.
- Hostel boarders will need to pay an Accommodation Fee of Rs. 1,200/- by the 10th of each month at the University Office.
- 4 Meal charges need to be paid separately to the relevant catering services.
- The University reserves the right to change / upgrade the Hostel Fees after six months.
- **AT-PCR** Test will be done at the time of admission.
- **4** Admission to the Hostel has been granted primarily on the basis of distance.
- Those allotted accommodation at the PG Girls' Hostel must get Consent forms signed by parents / guardians (to maintain the Covid Protocol and to allow RT-PCR tests in hostel premises).
- RT-PCR tests for hostel boarders is mandatory after every night-stay outside of the hostel / university campus. Those charges need to be borne by concerned students. Boarders will be allowed accommodation in the Hostel only after submission of RT-PCR test reports.
- Documents to be submitted for allotment of Room No. to Ms. Sanghamitra Purkait:
 - (i) Photocopy of University Admission Receipt
 - (ii) Photocopy of PG Girls' Hostel Admission Fee Receipt
 - (iii) Consent Form, signed by parent / guardian.

N.B. Mark-sheets will not be issued if the financial dues are not cleared if and when a boarder leaves the Hostel.
