<u>A Special Lecture on 'A Critical Reflection on the Nyāya Interpretation of Vāda,</u> Jalpa and Vitān<u>dā</u>

A special lecture was organized by the Department of Philosophy on 17th August, 2023 in the Smart Classroom of the Academic Building of the University. The speaker of the lecture was Professor Preetam Ghoshal, Dept. of Philosophy, Jadavpur University. The students of 2nd and 4th semester joined the lecture along with the teachers of the department.

The lecture began with an introduction of the speaker by Dr. Sharmistha Dhar. The speaker was felicitated by the students of the department. The speaker first gave an elaborate description and explanation of the background of Nyaya philosophy. This background also threw light on the other schools of Indian philosophy.
