Topic of the Day: 'An Outlook to Research: Introspection to Mind Game and Judgement in Research'

On 27th of March, 2021 (Saturday), a special lecture programme was arranged by the Department of Geography, Diamond Harbour Women's University to cultivate the academic quality. The speaker of the day was Professor Sanat Kumar Guchhait. At present, Professor Sanat Kumar Guchhait is enriching the Department of Geography of Burdwan University. Prof. Guchhait is an eminent professor of Geography having 14 years of teaching experience in this field.

Prof. Guchhait delivered a fine lecture on an outlook inquiry to research methodology. The whole lecture was divided in two phases. In first phase, Prof. Guchhait briefly discussed the **sampling** and relevant statistical methods for quality research especially **the concept of Hypothesis**. He has explained the complex concepts of **hypothesis testing, types of hypothesis** and **hypothesis error** in a simple way along with the suitable examples.

Prof. Guchhait made an effort to explain '**An Outlook to research: Introspection to mind game and judgement in research**' in the second part of his lecture. In this session, the focus point had been made on the thought process of a researcher. It is important to know that how a researcher should behave, judge and see the things going around him or her. Prof. Guchhait explained the different ways of thinking to make it clear with the concept of **mind game, observation** and **judgement**. He used different kind of pictorial examples to establish his sayings.
